COVID-19 Update



- Sizable number of residents have been able to maintain employment through COVID-19 or are on fixed incomes
 - Majority of residents received stimulus checks from the recently passed President Biden stimulus bill
 - For an average family of four, this amount was \$5,600, which is significant for residents within Flagship REIT's communities
- Partnered with The Northern Kentucky Health Department to deploy COVID-19 vaccines to several communities
 - Vaccine clinics operated in various communities in Kentucky
 - Nearly 700 community residents received vaccines at Flagship's clubhouses





Total Portfolio Weighted Average Monthly Lot Rent


